NAPLAN – Year 3 & Year 5 students – Our Year 3 and Year 5 staff and students are currently preparing for the annual NAPLAN assessment, a standardised test undertaken by students across Australia. This year the NAPLAN Assessment will commence on Wednesday March 12th for our students and conclude on Tuesday March 18th. The NAPLAN test serves as a tool in gauging the educational landscape nationwide, providing insights into student performance.

At Oberon we believe that true learning encompasses growth, personal achievements, friendships, and social interactions—elements that are not measured by NAPLAN.

However, it's essential to recognise that the test is just one aspect of their academic journey, taking place on one particular day. It is not the sole indicator of their identity as learners.

Meet and Greets - This week we took some time to meet with families in our Meet and Greet Interviews. This is a valuable opportunity to better understand the role we all play in ensuring our young people grow in their learning and wellbeing and establish our important partnership between school and home.

I'd like to thank those families who took the time to meet with teachers, and our wonderful staff who stayed back late two nights in a row.

Accident Insurance, Medical Expenses and Ambulance cover - Please note that the Department (which includes our school) does not have accident insurance. Items of personal property that are lost, stolen or damaged at school is not the responsibility of Oberon Primary School or the Department. Staff and students are reminded not to bring items of value to school.

A reminder that parents/carers are responsible for any medical expenses (including ambulance costs) incurred if their child is injured or requires medical treatment or an ambulance, while at school or participating in a school activity.

I also inform you that parents/carers may not be called if an ambulance is required, until after an ambulance is called, depending on the situation. We encourage parents/carers to have up-to-date ambulance cover and medical insurance.

Mobile Phones - A reminder that the Department of Education has in place a mobile phone ban that requires students who bring mobiles phones to school to have them switched off and securely put away

during school hours. The department is requiring all schools to ensure this ban is in place and enforced from the start of the 2025 school year. The ban applies equally to all government schools right across the state. This helps ensure that school is a learning environment free from unnecessary distractions and disruptions. By ensuring mobile phones are kept away at recess and lunch times, students can interact with each other face-to-face, without the distractions and social pressures that mobile phones can cause. I ask for the support of all our families, staff and students in continuing to support the implementation of this policy in our school.

Annual privacy reminder for our school community - Our school collects and uses student and parent personal information for standard school functions or where permitted by law, as stated in the Schools' Privacy Policy and the Schools' Privacy Collection Notice.

Our Photographing, Filming and Recording Students Policy describes how we collect and use photographs, video and recordings of students. The policy also explains when parent consent is required and how it can be provided and withdrawn.

I enjoy spending time with my friends and family, as well as travelling.


What are you looking forward to this year?
