The mornings are getting a little cooler, and many of us are wearing warmer clothing. At Oberon Primary School, it is an expectation that children wear the school uniform, and we have several options available to help keep children warm.

- 3 to 14 August 2026: Schools notify parents/carers of the outcome of enrolment applications.
- 28 August 2026: Parents and carers who receive an enrolment offer should respond to the offer.
- 28 August 2026: Written appeals from parents and carers are to be lodged with schools.
- 11 September 2026: Schools notify parents/carers in writing of the outcome of appeals.
